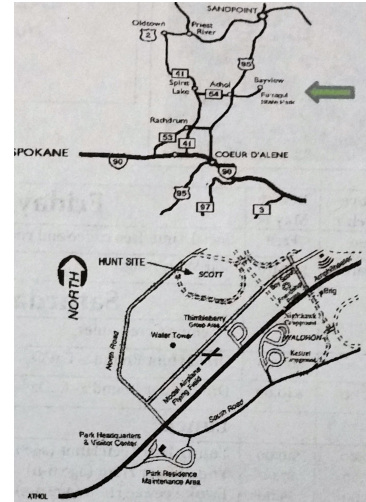

REMINDER OF THE MAIN HUNT RULES:

1. No hunting in the hunt fields until the hunt chairman gives the okay.
2. Only one detector may be used-pinpointers are allowed.
3. Digging tools will be checked-maximum width of 3/8 inch. **FILL ALL HOLES!**
4. No one other than the contestants or officials allowed on the hunt fields.
5. The remaining rules may be found in your packets.

CAMPING AND VEHICLE INFORMATION-PLEASE READ!

1. Every vehicle must pay the parking fee at the park office-\$5 per day per vehicle. A yearly pass is available for Idaho State Parks. It is \$30 per year-Idaho residents can get a great discount at the DMV.
2. You must show proof of vehicle payment before you can pick up your hunt packet.
3. Campers pay a \$12 fee per campsite per night stayed. This is to be paid to the club either on the form or at registration. We will need a head count of how many people are camping at each campsite at registration.

Hunt Raffle

The 6 for \$5 price is good with mailed in registration or at the hunt. Tickets will be available at the hunt. First prize is a Dragon's Hoard of GOLD and SILVER valued at \$500 or more. Second to fifth prize are silver rounds.

Saturday Hunts:

The Dragon Fire Hunt will be over 200 targets per entrant. Prizes will include GOLD, SILVER, and MORE.
The Dragon's Egg Hunt will have Dollars, Halves, and Quarters planted in the field! There will be tokens good for GOLD and SILVER PRIZES and DRAGON'S EGGS containing cash prizes from \$5 to \$50!
The Kid's hunts will be the same as normal assuming we have enough entries. Awards given right after the hunts.
The Dragon's Challenge Hunt will have tokens for Gold and Silver and SPECIAL TOKENS. They will allow you to advance to the second round of competition!
The Dragon's Lair Night Hunt will start at dusk and last about 30 minutes. Watch out for Dragon Droppings!

Sunday Hunts:

The Dragon's Treasure Hunt will have only quarters, halves, and dollars planted in the field. Tokens will be good for GOLD and SILVER!
The Dragon Hunters Hunt will be planted with clad coins. Tokens will be good for GOLD, SILVER, PROOF SETS, COLLECTOR COINS, and MORE!

What else will be happening over the weekend to keep you out of trouble? On Friday night, we will have a social hour with cookies and coffee. There could be a SURPRISE!

On Saturday night, we'll be hosting a free Chicken Feed and potluck dinner. We'll supply the main course and drinks. We'll also have utensils, paper plates, napkins, and condiments. You get to bring your favorite dessert, side dish, or salad. We're expecting great stuff. Donations are appreciated.

We will have the Plinko board set up and probably some other entertainment.
